CHECK-IN & LOCATION INFORMATION:

We plan to offer an opportunity for students who make a first time decision for Christ, to be baptized. If your child is interested in baptism we will make sure you are contact and can be present for their baptism. Baptisms will happen around 4:15pm @ the church on 2/16.

Pick up for campers will be at 5:30pm on Sunday (2/16) back @ your host home.

Basic Information:

MEDICATIONS:

We will have Medical Staff at the entire event. If your child has medications that need to be administered, please be sure it is labeled with the name of the medication, dose, and how often the medication needs to be administers. Please put all medications in a large ziplock bag with campers name written on the bag. **ALL MEDICATIONS should be given to a group leader upon arriving at your host home**. Our Medical Staff and Group Leaders will make sure medications are taken appropriately. Medications will be returned to parents at pick up or after the event has concluded.

PERSONAL BELONGINGS:

- Please read FULLY the "What to bring" page. ALL ITEMS should be marked with your camper's name if at all possible.
- NO ELECTRONICS... PLEASE... do a pat down of your child if you have to. We simply want them to disconnect from the crazy world... and connect to God!

Baptisms

Every year we offer campers and staff the opportunity to publicly confess and demonstrate their decision to follow Jesus through baptism. We love baptisms at camp and think it's a great thing for everyone to see and celebrate.

In an effort to be prepared we wanted to let you know that for Winter Weekend we will be doing Baptisms at 4:15 PM on Sunday Afternoon (February 19th). Due to the logistics of this event, we do ask that only the families of those being baptized attend, as we will not have enough space for everyone at the same time.

If your child has not been baptized, take a moment before Winter Weekend and discuss if this is something they might be considering so you can plan accordingly.

What to Bring:

PLEASE MARK EVERYTHING WITH NAME!

HOW TO PACK: for Winter Weekend please pack everything in one overnight bag or small suitcase, along with one sleeping bag, bed roll, etc.

CLOTHING LIST: (mark with child's name please)

- 2 pairs of pants
- 2 short-sleeved tops (will be given camp t-shirt that is washed daily)
- 2 long-sleeved shirt or sweatshirt
- Sleepwear
- 4 sets of underwear
- 3 pairs of athletic socks
- 1 pair of athletic shoes to wear daily
- Anything else you might need to stay warm (optional)

SLEEPING GEAR & TOWELS

- One sleeping bag
- Pillow (if desired, none are provided)
- Towel (mark w/ name please)

PERSONAL ITEMS:

- Bible (MUST BRING)
- Toiletries-hairbrush, comb, toothpaste, toothbrush, deodorant, soap, shampoo, sunscreen, etc.
- Medication (will be collected and administered by Group Leaders or our medical staff, unless otherwise notified by parents)
- A Case of Soda (12 or 24 pack)

- **A water bottle** (with campers full name written somewhere)
- Your favorite board game or card game (optional)
- Spending money for camp merch (optional)

DO NOT BRING:

- Valuables such as jewelry
- NO handheld games, IPADS, or any other electronic devices
 (we just don't need these... check your kids to be sure!)
- NO Cell phones (can be collected and given back at end of camp)
- NO Weapons of any kind including pocket knives
