What is the Adult Ministries Team?

The Adult Ministries Team is made up of people who have a heart to help other adults find connection and growth. Through hosting, leading and facilitating groups, our team members help create environments for our neighbors to find their place, find their people, and find their purpose.

Why is the Adult Ministries team vital to our ministry at PCC?

The Adult Ministries Team is a crucial part of helping our neighbors find and follow Jesus. This team helps provide the relational infrastructure that allows for sustainable church growth.

Through various classes and group settings, and events the Adult Ministry is focused on helping our neighbors find people to connect with as they learn more about Jesus and what it means to follow Him.

If I joined this team, when would I need to be available?

Depending on the type of group the time commitment could be anywhere from 1-4 hours per month. Many classes meet weekly for a season, while Life Groups meet at least once per month. Other days/time commitments are event dependent.

What is the Facilities and Grounds Team?

The Facilities and Grounds consists of hard-working team members that sacrificially serve and are not afraid to get sweaty and dirty. They use their skills and passions by fixing and or cleaning a wide range of things at PCC. The list ranges from changing light bulbs, vacuuming after special functions, to helping with special projects. Some members serve by setting up chairs in the sanctuary for Sunday service. While others help by maintaining the exterior of the church; they mow the grass, weed eat, help with landscape, spread mulch, spray weeds, and or filling potholes.

Why is the Facilities and Grounds team vital to our ministry at PCC?

The Facilities and Grounds Team is a crucial part of helping our neighbors find and follow Jesus. This Team promotes and creates a safe and welcoming environment for our congregation, neighbors and community.

They help maintain the church in proper operating conditions. Most of our team members work behind the scenes to ensure the facilities and grounds run smoothly and efficiently – making it inviting for anyone who walks through our doors.

If I joined this team, when would I need to be available?

Availability and need would depend on the purpose and position of the role. Some of the jobs are seasonal, while others can be year-round. And, depending on the position, they vary on frequency and can be completed weekly, biweekly, or yearly.

They hold the doors and greet people warmly as they arrive on campus. Some also serve behind the scenes ensuring that our environments are safe and secure.

Why is the First Impressions Team vital to our ministry at PCC?

The First Impressions Team is a crucial part of helping our neighbors find and follow Jesus. This team helps guests feel welcomed in a number of ways. On this team you can be out front greeting people with a smile and helping them find what they need.

There are also ways to join this team and serve behind the scenes, designing stage sets for our sermon series, making coffee or helping with safety and security.

All these things accomplish the important work of helping our neighbors feel welcomed and invited to be part of what God is doing.

If I joined this team, when would I need to be available?

For the roles connected to the Sunday morning services, team members typically serve once a month for an hour and a half. Other roles such as stage design, communications, etc. are more flexible.

What is the Kids Ministry Team?

We work to partner with and equip parents to be the primary spiritual influencers in the life of their child.

Why is the Kids Ministry Team vital to our ministry at PCC?

The Kids Ministry Team is a crucial part of helping our neighbors find and follow Jesus. This team partners with and serves families by providing a safe place for kids to meet Jesus and learn more about His word. This team is the heartbeat of sharing God's love and Biblical truth with children in our community. Through this ministry we encourage kids to be a great neighbor by inviting their friends to join them as they discover what it looks like to find and follow Jesus.

If I joined this team, when would I need to be available?

For the roles connected to the Sunday morning services, which includes Kindergarten through 3rd grade, leaders serve during one service for one month and then are off the following month.

Preschool, Nursery, Check-In and Bible Milestone leaders serve one service, once a month. The 4th-5th grade group (re:mix) meets every week on Wednesday evening from August through May for 2 hours. Other roles on the Kids Ministry Team are more flexible.
